

Math Interventionist (5-8)

The Grades 5-8 Math Interventionist serves as a mathematics teacher/interventionist, providing support for students struggling in the area of mathematics and numeracy development with the use of multiple curricula, tools, techniques to promote student mathematic concept mastery. The primary position objectives are to provide small group or one on-one instruction to students needing value-added instruction to close gaps, while monitoring and improving student achievement to ensure that all students meet grade level proficiency benchmarks.

The successful candidate will: work extensively with students to help improve specific mathematical skills; consults frequently with classroom teachers to design and plan interventions; conducts assessments to identify areas for continued student growth; diagnose math strengths and weaknesses and match these skills with appropriate techniques and materials to promote interest in math concepts.

The successful candidate will have extensive experience in the concepts and structure of elementary and middle school math, and will possess math certification (5-9) or elementary teacher certification, or 7-12 math certification with a desire to attain a 5-6 extension in the course of employment.
