SUBJECT: OCCUPATIONAL EXPOSURE TO HAZARDOUS LABORATORY CHEMICALS

The Board of Education recognizes its responsibility to protect students and employees from the hazards associated with laboratory work.

The Board directs the Superintendent to appoint a Chemical Hygiene Officer who is qualified by training or experience to provide technical guidance in the development and implementation of a Chemical Hygiene Plan (CHP). The CHP shall set forth the necessary work practices and procedures that are capable of protecting students and employees from potentially hazardous chemicals used in school laboratory facilities.

The Chemical Hygiene Plan shall be reviewed annually by the Board of Education.
