## SUBJECT: QUORUM AND ATTENDANCE OF THE BOARD OF EDUCATION

The quorum for any meeting of the Board shall be five members. No formal action shall be taken at any meeting at which a quorum is not present. Provided a quorum exists, the Board shall act by unanimous affirmative vote unless otherwise required by the laws of the State of New York.

The Superintendent and members of his/her staff at the Superintendent's discretion shall attend all meetings of the Board. The Superintendent shall attend all executive session meetings of the Board except those that concern his/her evaluation and salary determination. The Board may authorize the attendance of such additional persons as it desires.
