New York State Boating Safety Course

This course is designed as a comprehensive boating safety course. It teaches the fundamentals of safe boating operation and has been approved by the National Association of Boating Law Administrators (NASBLA). Students must be at least 10 years of age to attend the course. This course requires a minimum of 8 hours of classroom instruction. You must register for a course by calling the contact number provided. Students will receive a temp. Boating safety cert. upon completion of the course. Permanent boating safety certificates do not expire. Students 18 years of age and older will be required to pay a \$10 fee to NYS for issuance of a permanent boating safety certificate.

Who Needs the boating safety certificate?

Motorboats

Brianna's Law

If you were born on or after May 1, 1996 you will need a boating safety certificate. Those born on or after Jan. 1, 1993 will need a boating safety certificate beginning in 2020. Those born on or after Jan. 1, 1988 will need a boating safety certificate beginning in 2022. Those born on or after Jan. 1, 1983 will need a boating safety certificate beginning in 2023. Those born on or after Jan. 1, 1978 will need a boating safety certificate beginning in 2024. All motor boat operators regardless of age will need a boating safety certificate beginning in 2025.

Personal Water Craft (PWC)

Anyone operating a Personal Watercraft (JetSki™, Wave Runner™, etc.) must have a boating safety certificate, and be at least 14 years of age or older.

Non-motorized Boats

Operators of sailboats, kayaks, standup paddleboards, rowboats, canoes and any other watercraft without a motor are not required to have a boating safety certificate to be on the water. However, it is always a good idea to take a boating course to have a better understanding of the rules of the water.
